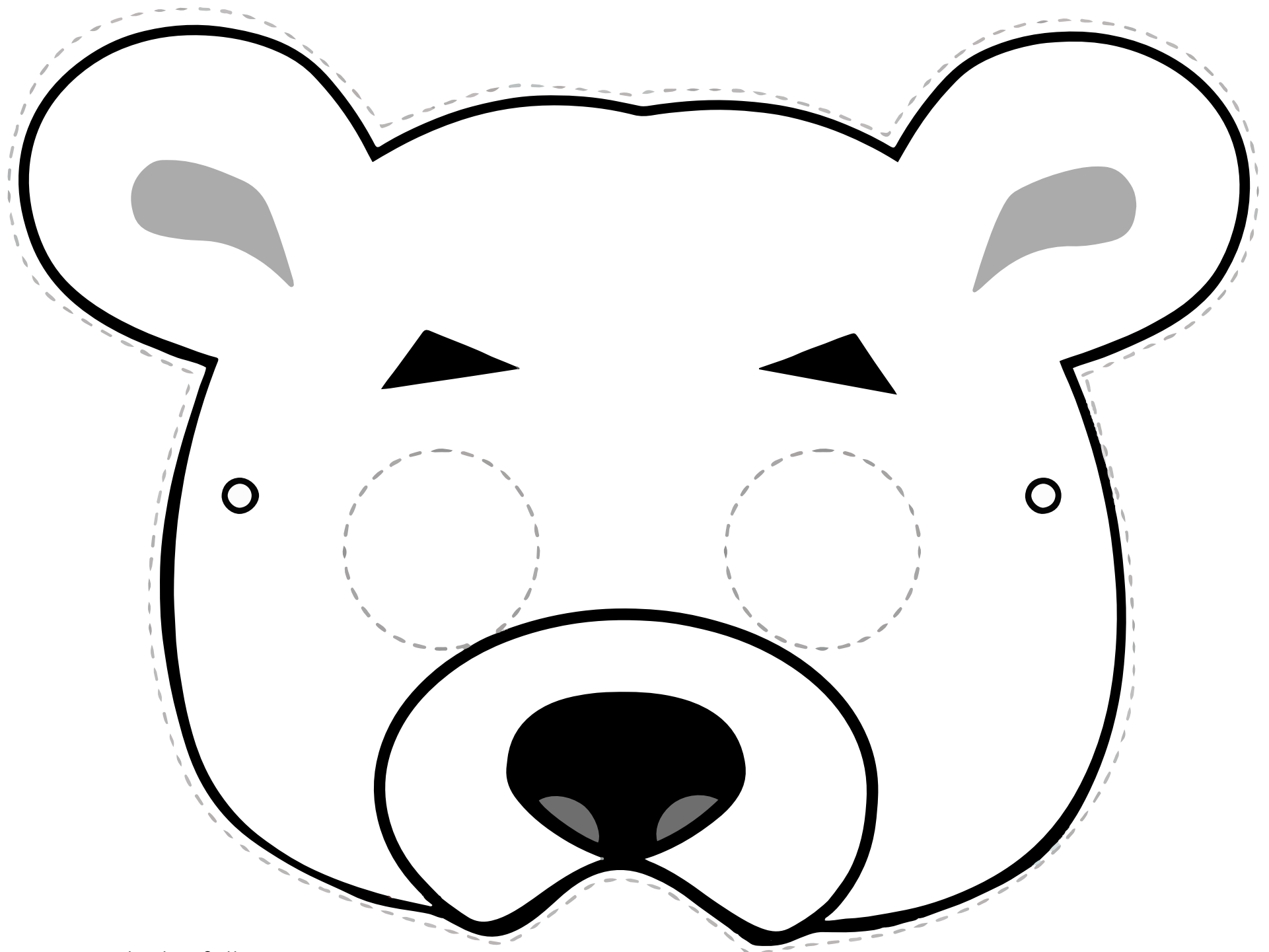
You will need to thread a string/ribbon/elastic through the two holes on the sides to create the mask.
